8.1 Sharks 26 v Giants 24

The lead up weather on Friday morning wasn't good but spring turned on another fantastic day for the local Derby against the Giants.

As home side we took the field first with Brendan at pitcher with Hayden at 1st teaming up for some very close plays, but just missing the outs. Brendan had a perfect catch for our first out, followed quickly by Finn fielding his base at 2nd. TJ at SS fielded the next followed by Cooper at 3rd both within inches of great outs. With bases loaded a ground ball to Hayden finished their batters with a put out at 1st for only 3 runs. Up at bat little Cooper stared us off solidly with great hits also from Kane, TJ, Brendan and Tiana all safe on bases with Hayden, Henry and Marvin followed by Alex and before you knew it we were 6 away. 6-3 our way.. good solid start.

Our second fielding lineup saw Finn on 1st with TJ throwing from pitcher twice, but they managed to squeeze onto base thanks to some great running.
